Basque News

Euskal Kultura resported this "past February the Basques of Lima, Peru resurrected what many consider the oldest Basque "club" in the Americas named originally Cofradia de Nuestra Señora de Aranzazu (in Basque *Arantzazu'ko Amaren Kofradia* or Brotherhood of the Virgin of Arantzazu). The brotherhood would have been 400 years old this coming November, had it not been abolished by the Peruvian Government and its assets nationalized in 1865. (Back then there was a lot of anti-Spanish sentiment in the newly-independent nations of the Americas--and, needless to say, the Basques, including those from Iparralde, were considered Spanish nationals).

The old brotherhood will be set up according to the current-day rules of *Euskal Etxeak* or Basques clubs throughout the world. The Basques of Lima plan to celebrate the 400th anniversary by publishing a book on the history of the organization."
